Access II – Ed "Eddie" Grimes Scholarship

Ed "Eddie" Grimes at the age of 38 enrolled in college and graduated from North Central Missouri College in 1992. He completed his post-secondary education graduating Salutatorian with a B.A. in Creative Writing from Missouri Western State College in 1997. Eddie was awarded a full scholarship to attend UMKC Law School; unfortunately was unable to fulfill his dream due to a diagnosis of end-stage emphysema.

Eddie understood the difficulties of everyday life as a person with a disability. Diagnosed with osteoporosis, osteoarthritis, and emphysema he got around using a wheelchair and oxygen. But that didn't deter him.

When Eddie was not a student, he continued on the path of education by helping others. In 1997 Eddie became a teacher for the Adult Education Center in Gallatin, MO. He was a great role model but he would tell you himself that he wasn't a hero. He did all the he could to help local residents fulfill their dreams of attaining their GEDs, developing computer skills, and gaining the knowledge to live more independently.
