Scholarship Criteria:

- 2. The student must have at least a 2.5 GPA on a 4 point scale.**
- 3. The student must submit a one page essay on their future plans in the agricultural field they plan to enter and tell us how that could potentially impact Harrison County. Essay is to be typed with size 12 font Times New Roman.**
- 4. The student will be awarded the scholarship upon starting their second semester of college or technical school.**
- 5. The candidate does not need to be a member of the Harrison County Cattlemen's Association to be considered for the scholarship.**
- 6. Application must be completed and returned to Dan Chalfant by April 1, 2022.**
